The essentials!

**aigues-mortes**, whose origins go back to the dawn of time, is in constant motion. From the earliest mankind, through Antiquity, the Middle Ages, and the French Revolution, Aigues-Mortes bore witness to this history and that of the people who shaped her. Nestled in hostile lands between the Mediterranean Sea and the marshlands, she has persistently preserved her age-old ramparts.

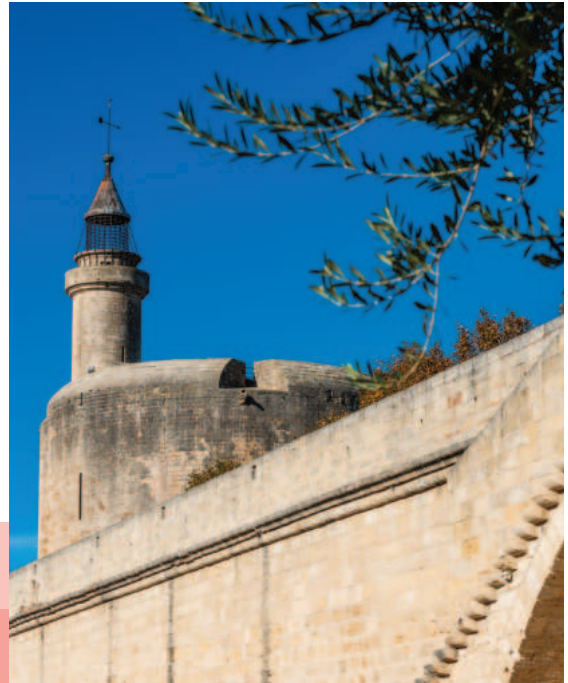
An exquisite treasure chest, full of jewels that fascinate us and incite us to explore: the fortifications envisioned by Louis IX and completed by his son and grandson; the church in which Louis IX came to kneel before departing on a crusade; the chapels of Penitents, whose faith was so profound that they offered their time and their efforts to support those in need; the saltworks that provided work and the precious commodity that allowed to preserve food; finally Tour Carbonnière that watched over this city.

These architectural marvels, highlighted by the waterfront boardwalk at southern ramparts, or that within the Maison Grand Site de France, are a delight for all explorers.

## AIGUES-MORTES MONUMENT: TOUR DE CONSTANCE AND THE RAMPARTS

Tour de Constance (The Constance Tower) is erected in 1240, conforming to the wishes of Louis IX. The city, surrounded by 1634 meters of ramparts, is built during the reign of Philippe III The Bold, heir to Saint Louis, and is later completed under the rule of his grandson, Philippe IV The Handsome.

The top terrace crowning Tour de Constance offers a 360° panorama. The whole structure comprises 10 gates and 6 towers.



## NOTRE-DAME-DES-SABLONS CHURCH



In 1246, the Church of Notre-Dame-des-Sablons was built in stone, comprising Gothic-style pointed arches, on the site of an earlier church made of wood and reeds. She has been ransacked many times over, transformed and revamped over the centuries. The last "modification" made was in the form of 31 contemporary stained-glass windows, installed in 1991.

These stained-glass windows, conceived by the painter Claude Vialat and the glasswork master Bernard Dhonneur were created using hand-blown antique glass.



## GREY PENITENTS' CHAPEL

The first chapel was built around the 1400s on the spot of an ancient convent of monks known as The Cordeliers. It was later destroyed during the Wars of Religion, and then rebuilt at the beginning of the 17<sup>th</sup> century.

The chapel houses a primitive baroque-style altar; it is the work of Jean Sabatier, a sculptor from Montpellier, representing the *Passion of Christ*.

## WHITE PENITENTS' CHAPEL

Constructed in 1623, this neo-classical chapel houses a monumental fresco by the painter Xavier Sigalon and four paintings by Auguste Glaise depicting the life of the Virgin Mary.

The remarkably painted fresco retraces *The descent of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost Day*.





## CHAPELLE DES CAPUCINS

Situated in Saint Louis Square, The Capuchin Chapel is the only vestige of the 17<sup>th</sup>-century convent. Erected using the stones from an ancient jetty, with its single rectangular nave, this chapel is not traditionally facing east.

After the convent was sold in 1791, the disused chapel first served as military storage, then a coffee room, a public hall, and even a tourist office. It is now a venue for art exhibitions.



## LE GRAND SITE DE FRANCE DE LA CAMARGUE GARDOISE



Maison du Grand Site de France de la Camargue Gardoise, situated on the protected site of *La Marette*, is a place to discover the landscapes, flora, fauna, and the human activities connected to them.

This natural site features a 1.6 km pedestrian trail, an exhibit hall, and hosts a range of events.

## LE SALIN D'AIGUES-MORTES



The first saltworks go back to Antiquity. At the beginning of the 13<sup>th</sup> century, nearly all saltworks of Peccais belonged to the Psalmody Monks. Nowadays, the saltworks of Aigues-Mortes stretch across an area of 9800 hectares. Over a period of five months, the sea water circulates throughout the flats and progressively concentrates, allowing for crystallization to take place.

The harvested salt is then stored in a *camelle*, a genuine salt mountain 20 m high and 400 m long.

## LA TOUR CARBONNIÈRE

La Tour Carbonnière and surrounding marshes also make up part of the Grand Site de France.

This tower, the former tollgate granting access to the city of Aigues-Mortes, dates back to the 13<sup>th</sup> century. She presides solely over her marshes, overlooking a vast area populated by plant and animal species characteristic of the Camargue Gardoise. The tower is accessible throughout the year, free of charge, and can be easily reached on foot, by bike or by car from Aigues-Mortes.



## THE GRAND SITE DE FRANCE BOARDWALK AT SOUTH RAMPARTS

At the south perimeter of the fortification, flanking the pond, a boardwalk winds over the vegetation. Straight ahead, a jetty facing the salt marshes projects over the dyke, where ducks can be spotted regularly.

To the east, the boardwalk snakes between the reeds and the dyke. As if halted in time, sense of calm and silence of this place soothe and rejuvenate.



## LOCAL CULINARY SPECIALITIES

The local specialty is Aigues-Mortes *fougasse*, prepared with brioche pastry, sugar, butter, and orange flower essence. The *Gardiane*, a slow-cooked stew of Camarguais bull meat marinated in red wine, always accompanied by rice from Camargue.

The *cannelé Camarguaise* (fluted pastry) whose shape is inspired by the La Tour de Constance, owes its original taste to the orange flower essence, much like the Aigues-Mortes *fougasse*.

## AIGUES-MORTES IN KEY POINTS



### THE ORIGINS OF AQUAE MORTAE (DEAD WATERS)

**I** The lands around Aigues-Mortes have been occupied from the dawn of mankind. During the Age of Antiquity, a Greek colony settled here, followed by the Romans in the 1<sup>st</sup> century, who were already organizing the production and exploitation of salt.





## LOUIS IX IN AIGUES-MORTES

2

In the 5<sup>th</sup> century, in the middle of swamps and ponds, amidst a hostile environment, the Benedictine Monks settle and establish an abbey: "Psalmody". In the 13<sup>th</sup> century, Louis IX negotiates with the Benedictine Monks for the purchase of Aigues-Mortes lands. Over the following years, the entire kingdom devotes itself to an enormous endeavor: the construction of a city and a royal port.

## THE CRUSADES

3 In 1248, Louis IX departs for the Seventh Crusade. The city does not yet exist, only the port of Aigues-Mortes is established. In 1270, Louis IX takes leave for the Eighth Crusade and dies on August 25, 1270. The foundations of the ramparts are only partly laid. The fallen king's son, Philippe III The Bald and his grandson Philippe IV The Handsome take over and finish the construction at the end of the 13<sup>th</sup> century.

## THE 100-YEAR WAR

In 1481, the port of Marseille is annexed to the kingdom of France. Additionally, the floodplain deposits at the Rhône delta as well as the silting up and clogging of inlets trigger the decline of the port of Aigues-Mortes. In the 15<sup>th</sup> century, a civil war between the Armagnacs and the Burgundians tears France apart. In Aigues-Mortes, the governor Louis of Malpüe, in an act of treason, hands the city over to the Burgundians.

## THE FRENCH WARS OF RELIGION

5

In 1575, during the French Wars of Religion, the Protestants plunder, burn and ransack the city and all the catholic religious monuments. In 1685, after the revocation of the Edict of Nantes, the Huguenots were once again persecuted.

## THE PRISONERS OF THE TOWER

Tour de Constance becomes a women's prison for captives of all ages and all social classes. Marie Durand, most infamous of the prisoners, remains imprisoned for 38 years.



# 7

## THE FRENCH REVOLUTION

The French Revolution does not spare Aigues-Mortes. Everything to do with religion is either destroyed or diverted from its original purpose. At the beginning of the 19<sup>th</sup> century, freedom of worship is reestablished, the churches are returned to the faithful and religious peace is restored.



# 8

## AIGUES-MORTES TODAY

In 1806, the construction of the Canal du Rhône à Sète is completed. From then on, Aigues-Mortes becomes a river port for the transport of goods, and later passengers. In 1903, the ramparts of Aigues-Mortes become classified as a historical monument.

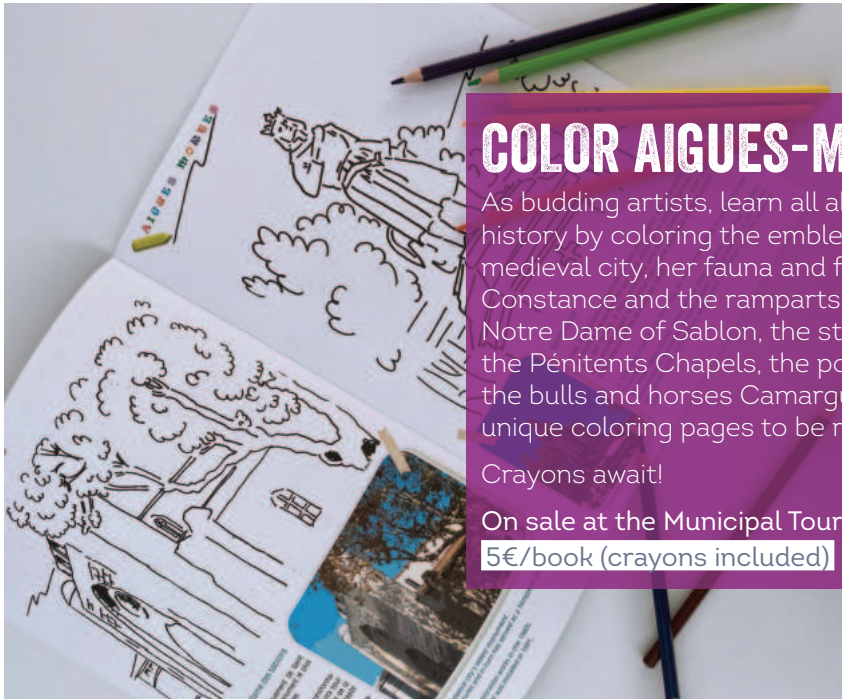

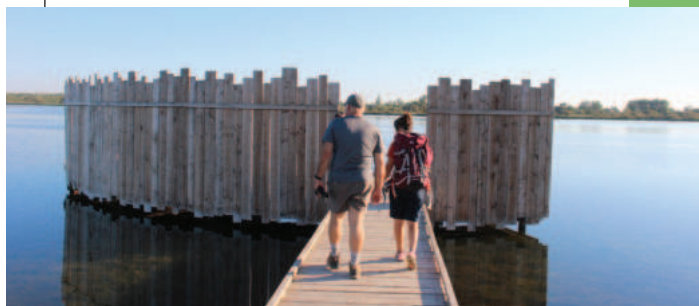

# ON FOOT OR BY BIKE?

Unique and mysterious, Camargue reveals its beauty through the landscapes: the ponds and canals, salt mounds, prairies, and marshes, *sansouïres* and reed beds, vineyards and pine forests. On foot or by bike, take the time to explore and discover its richness.

What can be more enjoyable than renting a bicycle and letting yourself be carried away by your fancy? By way of a "green" bike path that runs alongside the canals, take off on an effortless adventure, taking advantage of the flat terrain.

If you go in the direction of the Mediterranean beaches, tune into the sound of rigging stroking masts of sailboats docked in port, admire the pink salt marsh waters and the salt mounds from afar, and observe the pink flamingo colonies permanently settled here.

If you head north, follow a branch of the Rhône à Sète canal, climb to the top of Tour Carbonnière and take in one of the most spectacular views of the Camargue. Nestled in the marshes, at the heart of an exceptional natural setting, this former outpost of the city of Aigues-Mortes is accessible 24/7. Keep an eye out for grey herons, pink flamingos, and nutria!

For an effortless tour of Camargue, hop on an electric bike and follow the guide. Get personally acquainted with the narrow paths, listen as birds and cicadas sing, get up close to the Camargue horses, even bulls, and treat yourself to a gourmet break by sampling local delicacies.

Whether you're a keen hiker or a leisurely stroller, stride through our 130 kms of footpaths at your own pace. Free of charge and accessible to all, the southern ramparts boardwalk is the perfect place for a stroll with your family. While the kids watch ducks and moorhens, contemplate the citadel of Aigues-Mortes rising amidst the reeds.

# A LIFE OF TRADITION!

Camargue, with its rich marshes and grazing lands, is a microcosm that is ideal for rearing wild cattle. The Camargue *biòu*, a black bull with lyre-shaped horns, today bred semi-wild, has been one of the emblems of our region and part of our way of life for centuries.

In Aigues-Mortes we have the *fè di biòu*! We are passionate about Camargue-bred bulls, and we like to share our passion and preserve our traditions.

Immerse yourself in this culture, meet a rancher and visit a *manade*, a bull and horse farm emblematic of our region. The work and passion of the *manadier* and his *gardians*, will hold no more secrets for you.

We will shed light on the meaning of accessories prized by the *gardians*, such as the trident, with which he sorts the bulls in the herd. We find it on the Camargue cross, formed together with an anchor and a heart. These three emblems symbolize faith, hope and charity.

Beginning in spring, between April and October, across this region abounding in tradition, *courses camarguaise* (the camarguaise races) set the pace for village life.

Take the time to immerse yourself in the Camargue Gardoise by attending a "race": the fervor of the aficionados will surprise you. No executions here, just the ballet of men dressed in white facing the bulls, punctuated by their frantic jumps and runs.

The *raseteur*, dressed in white, and equipped with his hook, braves the bull to win the "attributes" attached to the horns: a cockade, strings, and tassels, and thus winning a prize.

Here, racing bulls die of old age in the meadows. The greatest *cocardiers* are entitled to a grave in their *manade* and are ceremoniously buried standing up.

Strolling through Aigues-Mortes, you will discover strange paintings on the walls and doors of the houses: the *empègues*, stencil drawings made by the village youth as part of fundraising for the votive festival, to finance their festivities.

After having discovered the Camargue traditions, *Abrivado*, *Bandido* or *Roussatario* will no longer be a mystery to you!

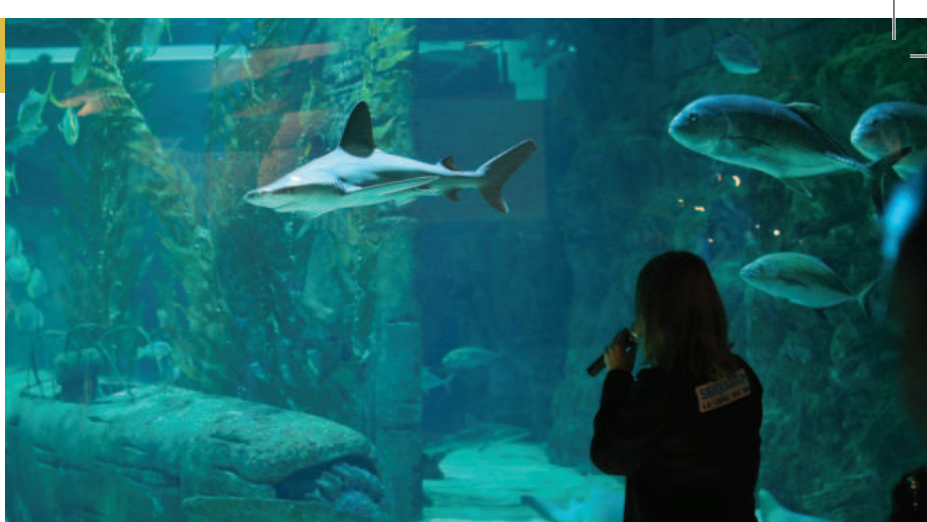

Between the sea and the ponds lie exceptional lands: vineyards grow on sand dunes brought in by the river Rhône, sea, and wind that forge the coastal strip or lido and its unique landscapes. It is between lagoons and salt ponds that the biological diversity of the environment reveals its splendor with more than 1000 species of fauna and flora catalogued.

The sand here is very homogeneous, at least 80% is devoid of clay and silt, and is distinctly of marine origins.

Wines produced here are reflective of the soil that nourishes the vines. They are characterized by their finesse, delicacy, lightness, and their airy nature.

Their complexity is a result of blending of different grape varieties, which makes it possible to produce unique wines and grants a real distinction to the viticultural terroir of Sable de Camargue. Our wines go perfectly with the most refined meals as well as the simplest dishes.

Prominent "*gris*" and "*gris de gris*" wines perfectly reflect the terroir with their pale salmon color, their elegant taste profile, and their freshness. The aromas express themselves with nuance and delicacy, much like the surrounding Camargue landscapes. The white wines present the same characteristics, influenced only by the nature of the grape varieties used.

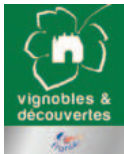

On a regional scale, this label testifies to the commitment of all those involved (winegrowers, accommodation providers, restaurateurs, tourist offices, etc.) to work together to develop quality tourist services based around the vine, combining aspects of discovery (tours, visits, natural sites, know-how, museum...), hospitality (winegrowers, accommodation, workshops, cellars, etc.) and events (festivals, exhibitions, conferences, etc.).

The "*Vignobles Vidourle Camargue*" destination, awarded the label in 2020 and again in 2023, is made up of four appellations, including the AOP Sable de Camargue (PDO - Protected Designation of Origin - Sable de Camargue). To date, the "*Vignobles Vidourle Camargue*" destination has 127 partners.
